SPIRITUAL GIFTS CATEGORIES

 Manifestation Gifts – 1 Corinthians 12:7-11 (gifts for all believers when needed)

Wisdom, Knowledge, Faith, Healing, Miracles, Prophecy, Distinguishing Spirits, Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues

II. Ministry Gifts – 1 Corinthians 12:28 and Ephesians 4:11 - (gifts given to those called to full time ministry)

1 Corinthians: Apostles, Prophets, Teachers, Miracles, Healing, Helping,

Administration, Tongues

Ephesians: Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors, Teachers

III. Motivational Gifts – Romans 12:6-8 (basic motivation that drives and defines one's ministry)

Prophecy, Serving (Helps), Teaching, Encouraging (Exhortation), Giving (Generosity), Administration (Leadership), Mercy (Compassion)

SPIRITUAL GIFTS FAQ

1. What is a Spiritual Gift?

Chuck Swindoll: "A skill or ability that enables each Christian to perform a function in the body of Christ with ease and effectiveness."

William McRae: "An ability to function effectively and significantly in a particular service as a member of Christ's body, the Church."

Charles Stanley: "Special abilities given to believers at conversion by the Holy Spirit for building up the body of Christ."

2. Who has a Spiritual Gift?

Every believer in Jesus Christ (Romans 12:5-6, 1 Corinthians 12:11, Ephesians 4:7)

3. How does a Christian get their Spiritual Gift?

As God determines (1 Corinthians 12:11)

4. What is the purpose of one's Spiritual Gift?

Utility, unity, and maturity for the church (Ephesians 4:11-12) Serve others and glorify God (1 Peter 4:10-11)

5. What is the difference between: A) the gifts of the Spirit, B) the gift of the Spirit, and C) the fruit of the Spirit?

- A. Gifts of the Spirit are given to believers by the Holy Spirit
- B. Gift of the Spirit is the Holy Spirit Himself
- C. Fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5:22-23)
