10. a. It was probably Paul who delivered the short sermon recorded in verses 15-17. Why did he say he was preaching? Give verse.

b. List as many things as you can that you learn about God from Paul's speech.

c. Take the list of things that you learned about God from Paul's speech and write down a few principles or lessons that you learned.

d. From the principles/lessons listed above, write down how you can apply them to your own life.

e. How did the people of Lystra respond? Give verse.

15. Where did Paul and Barnabas stop to preach the word on their way back to Antioch in Syria?

16. Why did they go to Syrian Antioch?

17. a. What did Paul and Barnabas report at the missionary meeting?

b. What do you think is the most exciting thing God had done with them? You may use chapter 13 also.

c. Tell how you might apply to your own life something exciting that God did in Paul and Barnabas' lives in chapters 13 & 14.

18. How long did they stay in Antioch?

DAY SIX: Review the first missionary journey in Acts 13 and 14

READING: Acts 13; Acts 14; Ephesians 2:11-18; Acts 14:26 [[Open NKJV](#)] [[Open NIV](#)]

19. How does Ephesians 2:11-18 describe what happened on this first missionary effort?

20. a. Acts 14:26 states that the missionaries had been *commended to the grace of God*. How had they seen the grace of God at work?

b. How have you seen the grace of God at work in the lives of you or your family?
