All questions are based on the New King James version of the Bible.

DAY ONE: Read all lesson notes and references.

1. If someone asked you what 1 Peter is about, what would you tell them?

2. a. In what practical ways has Peter's letter been beneficial to you?

- b. How did something from the lecture help you and why?

DAY TWO: Read all three chapters of 2 Peter.

READING: 2 Peter 1-3 [[Open NKJV](#)] [[Open NIV](#)]

3. a. From 2 Peter 1:1 and 16-18, what do you learn about the writer of this letter?

- b. List some things the letter reveals about the first recipients? Give verses.

4. a. Knowledge (also know and knowing), are key words in 2 Peter. Underline them in your Bible or write down the chapters and verses where they may be found.

- b. From the verses above, list some things Peter wants his readers to know.

- c. ? (Personal Question) From the list made in the previous question, what is something you can apply to your own life?

5. a. What stands out to you as the main theme of 2 Peter Chapter 2?

- b. From the third chapter of 2 Peter, what are believers to look for?

DAY FOUR: Read 2 Peter 1:5-11.
