Day 1 - Review

1. What did you find most interesting from the commentary notes?
2. What most encouraged you from the lecture?

3. a. To whom was this letter written?

b. How did John feel about him?
4. What do you learn about brotherly love from the following cross references?

Deuteronomy 10:19-

Matthew 22:39-

John 13:35-

1 Peter 1:22-

5. For what did John pray for his friend in v. 2?
6. According to Proverbs 4:20-23, what connection is there between physical and spiritual health?

7. (Personal Question) What might you do to enjoy good health of body and soul? Be specific with actual action steps.

Day 3 - Read 3 John 3-4 [\[Open NKJV\]](#) [\[Open NIV\]](#)

8. a. What gave John such great joy?

b. (Personal Question) Who is the person you know that brings you great joy because they continue to walk in the truth and are faithful to the truth? What about them specifically demonstrates their faithfulness to the truth?

9. (Challenge Question) In v. 4, John refers to his “children that are walking in the truth”. To whom is he referring?

10. John references “walking in the truth” multiple times. Try to define “walking in the truth” and write down an aspect of “walking in the truth” from the following cross references.

11. (Personal Question) What action might you take to insure that you are “walking in the truth”?

14. Who did John say should help these brothers and who was not expected to help them?

15. (Personal Question) What have you done lately to help a missionary spread the gospel? What could you do? What should you do?

16. (Challenge Question) According to v. 8, when a Christian assists a missionary, what does John conclude is the foundation of their relationship?

b. List the things that John exposes about him.
