All questions are based on the New King James Version of the Bible.

### DAY ONE: Read all lesson notes and references.

1. What did you learn about God's word?
  
2. a. What did you learn about the day of the Lord?

3. a. In what practical ways can you make daily progress in your Christian life?  
  
b. How has studying 2 Peter made a difference in the way you live?

### DAY TWO: Read all of Jude and re-read 2 Peter 2.

4. a. List seven commands given to believers in Jude's epistle. Give verses.  
  
b. ? (Personal Question) Which of these 7 commands brings the most conviction to your heart and why?
  
5. a. Find the word "ungodly" in Jude's epistle. Give verses.  
  
b. What things are described as ungodly?
  
6. Compare Jude and 2 Peter 2 and list some similarities that you find.

**DAY THREE: Read Jude 1:1-4.**

READING: *Jude 1:1-4* [[Open NKJV](#)] [[Open NIV](#)]

7. a. What do you learn from these verses about the author of Jude?  
  
b. What had he planned to write about?  
  
c. What did he feel compelled to write about?
8. What do you learn from these verses about the original recipients of the letter?
9. a. What does it mean to you to contend earnestly for the faith?  
  
b. Why did Jude say it was necessary to contend earnestly for the faith?
10. What do you learn about the false teachers in verse 4?

**DAY FOUR: Read Jude 5-15.**

READING: *Jude 1:5-15; Genesis 4:1-15; Hebrews 11:4; 1 John 3:12; Numbers 31:16; 2 Peter 2:15-16; Revelation 2:14; Numbers 22-24; Numbers 16:1-35* [[Open NKJV](#)] [[Open NIV](#)]

11. What did Jude want to remind his readers about?
12. What does he reveal about the false teachers in these verses?
13. a. What is the way of Cain? Use also Genesis 4:1-15; Hebrews 11:4 and 1 John 3:12.  
  
b. What was the error of Balaam? Use also Numbers 31:16; 2 Peter 2:15-16 and Revelation 2:14.  
(For more information about Balaam, see Numbers 22-24.)

14. a. Using Numbers 16:1-35, compare the false teachers and their fate to Korah and his followers.
- b. What one word in Jude 5-15 would best describe both the false teachers and Korah?
- c. ? (Personal Question) What is your main take away from today's lesson?

*READING: Jude 16-23; Acts 20:29-30; 1 Timothy 4:1; 2 Timothy 3:1-5; 2 Timothy 4:3-4; 2 Peter 2:1-3; 2 Peter 3:3-4; Romans 5:5; Romans 8:5-14; 1 John 3:24* [[Open NKJV](#)] [[Open NIV](#)]

16. a. What had the apostles of the Lord Jesus warned about?

- 2 Peter 2:1-3 and 3:3-4
17. a. What did Jude say false teachers do not have? Give verse.
- b. ? (Thought Question) What does this tell you about them? See Romans 5:5; Romans 8:5-14; and 1 John 3:24 for help.
18. a. From verses 20-23, list some things believers should do to combat false teachers.
- b. From your list in the previous question, how can you apply a biblical principle to your own life?

**DAY SIX: Read Jude 24-25.**
