Day 2 - Read Romans 1:1-7 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 2. Write down 3 things that you learn about Paul from verse 1.
- 3. What do learn about Jesus in verses 2-4?
- 4. **? Personal Question:** Using your answer to question 3, which fact about Jesus is most meaningful to you and why?
- 5. According to verses 5 & 6, why did Paul call Gentiles to faith in Jesus Christ?

Day 3 - Read Romans 1:8-17 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 6. **? Personal Question:** In verse 12, Paul uses the phrase "that you and I might be mutually encouraged by each other's faith." What do you think this means and when have you experienced "mutual encouragement" from another's faith?
- 7. **? Thought Question:** In verses 14 & 15, for what was Paul obligated?
- 8. Why was Paul not ashamed of the gospel according to verse 16?
- 9. According to verse 17, what is revealed in the gospel?
