3. What was the intent of the Northern Canaanite opposition in Joshua 11:1-5?
4. What did God tell Joshua and what happened in verses 6-9?
5. **? Thought Question:** What lesson do you learn from Joshua's interaction with God and the Northern Canaanite nations?
6. Using verse 15, how complete was Joshua's obedience to the Lord?
7. **? Personal Question:** In what area of your life have you given only partial obedience to the Lord and not total obedience to Him (some area of your marriage, your job, your church life, your personal holiness)? What steps are you willing to take to go from partial to full obedience?

8. **? Thought Question:** What does Joshua 11:20 say that God did to the hearts of Israel's enemies? What do you think this means?
9. Joshua 11:23 ends with "the land had rest from war." Read Hebrews 4:8 and describe the kind of rest Joshua gave the people of Israel.
10. Read Hebrews 4:9-12 and compare the kind of rest that Joshua gave versus the kind of rest Jesus gives.
11. **? Personal Question:** Write down how you might apply each verse below to better cease your own works and more fully experience God's rest.

15. **? Personal Question:** What in your life is the spiritual equivalent of 33 kings (kingdoms) claiming what belongs to you? How does this summary chapter of how God fought for His people comfort you in your situation?
