Day 2 Read Joshua 13:1-7 [\[Open NIV\]](#) [\[Open NKJV\]](#)

3. What was revealed about Joshua's age that was mentioned twice in verse 1?
4. What purpose did God have for Joshua despite his age?
5. **? Thought Question:** What is the principle being illustrated in verses 1-7?
6. **? Personal Question:** How might you apply this principle in your life?
(Note: Consider using this prayer, "Lord, do you have something you want me to do to impact your kingdom? I'm willing to do it; I just need you to inform me what it is.")

Day 3 Read Joshua 13:8-14, 33 [\[Open NIV\]](#) [\[Open NKJV\]](#)

7. To whom did Moses give the land east of the Jordan River?
8. What did the recipients of this land fail to do (verse 13)?
9. **? Thought Question:** Speculate as to the reasons why you think Israel failed to complete the job Moses started for them. Be prepared to share those reasons with your group.
10. **? Personal Question:** How have you ever failed God? And how do the reasons for your failure match up with your speculated reasons that Israel failed?
11. Which tribe did not receive any land as their inheritance? What did they receive instead (verses 14 and 33)?

12. **? Personal Question:** The Levites did not receive a tangible inheritance from God... their inheritance was God Himself! Do you ever want God's "stuff" more than God Himself? Be prepared to discuss with your group why you might sometimes feel that way.
