Day 1 - Review

1. What is something that impacted you from the lecture, commentary notes, group discussion or your personal study of the last lesson on Romans 15?

Day 2 - Read Romans 16:1-2 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 2. Who does Paul commend in verses 1 & 2 and for what reason?
- 3. What did Paul ask the Church at Rome to do for Phoebe in verses 1 & 2?
- 4. Personal Question: Describe the last time you helped someone in their ministry. What was your motivation? How were you rewarded?
- 5. State why you think Paul's commendation of Phoebe elevates women in ministry.

Day 3 - Read Romans 16:3-9 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 6. List all the people Paul says to greet in verses 3-9.
- 7. In general, describe the kind of relationship Paul had with the 9 individuals mentioned in verses 3-9.
- 8. Personal Question: Paul says in verses 3 & 4 that Priscilla (Prisca) and Aquila made great sacrifices, even risking their lives, on behalf of Paul. What great sacrifice has someone made on your behalf?

Day 4 - Read Romans 16:10-16 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

9. **? Personal Question:** Of all the individuals listed in verse 10-16, which one would you like to meet and why?

- 10. The phrase "in Christ" or "in the Lord" is mentioned several times about Paul's friends. Explain what it means for a person to be "in Christ" or "in the Lord."

- 12. What warning does Paul give to the Roman Church in verse 17?
- 13. In verse 17, Paul refers to the teaching (doctrine) the Roman Church has learned. Based on your study of Romans, summarize in a few short sentences the teaching (doctrine) that Paul gave them from this book.
- 14. **? Personal Question:** How would verse 20 encourage the Roman Church, and how does it encourage you today?
- 15. According to verse 22, what role did Tertius have in the writing of the book of Romans?

Day 6 - Read Romans 16:25-27 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 16. What are some facts you learn about the gospel in verses 25-26?
- 17. In verse 27, Paul gives glory to God through Jesus Christ. How is God glorified through Jesus Christ?
