18. According to Matthew 1:1-5, what great honor was bestowed on Rahab?
19. **? Thought Question:** What principle stands out to you from verses 17-24? (Look for a command to follow, a warning to heed, a lesson to learn, something you learn about God or mankind, something to stop doing or start doing. Make sure your principle is supported with other scripture.)
20. **? Personal Question:** How might you apply the principle listed in the previous question?

21. **? Thought Question:** What is your “bottom line” take away from Joshua 2?

22. Why was it important for the spies to give a good report to Joshua about what they saw while in Jericho?

23. According to the spies’ own words to Joshua in verse 24, how did God come through for Israel, once again?

24. **? Personal Question:** How has God “come through” for you? In other words, what promises from scripture has God been faithful to keep in your life? Start a list of ways God has kept his promises to you. Spend a few moments in prayer reflecting on God’s goodness to keep his promises to you. (If you aren’t real sure of God’s promises to you, read the following scriptures: Joshua 23:4, Romans 8:38-39, 1 John 1:9, 1 John 2:25, Philippians 4:6-7, Philippians 4:19, and James 1:5)
