Lesson 3: Exodus 3:1 – 4:31

Day 1: Read Exodus 3:1-9 [\[Open NIV\]](#) [\[Open NKJV\]](#)

1. Recount Moses's interaction with God.
2. Find an admirable character trait of Moses in today's text. How might you apply the trait Moses modeled?
3. What lesson do you learn about God's heart in this passage?

Day 2: Read Exodus 3:10-21 [\[Open NIV\]](#) [\[Open NKJV\]](#)

4. Why was Moses reluctant to do what God had commanded?
5. In what area of your life have you been reluctant to do what God commands? Admit (confess) your weakness and trust God by writing a short prayer about something in your life that requires your obedience.
6. What name for Himself did God tell Moses to use, if anyone asked (v. 13)?

7. The name of God given to Moses in v. 14 reveals the deep and mysterious nature of God. God is self-existent. He has no dependence on anyone or any other. He is eternal, unchangeable – the same yesterday, today and forever. Why would this be important for Moses to hear and believe?
8. How will you respond to God's revelation of Himself in v. 14?

Day 3: Read Exodus 4:1-9 [\[Open NIV\]](#) [\[Open NKJV\]](#)

9. Describe the 3 miraculous signs God gave to Moses.
10. What was God's purpose for giving Moses these signs?

Day 4: Read Exodus 4:10-17 [\[Open NIV\]](#) [\[Open NKJV\]](#)

11. Summarize vs. 10-12 and explain how God's response to Moses comforts you in a fearful circumstance you are preparing to encounter.
12. How did Moses answer God in v. 13? Has there ever been a time in your life when you begged God to "send someone else?" Explain.
13. Make a list of things communicated by God to Moses in vs. 14-17 that should have strengthened him in this time of weakness and fear.

14. How could you apply something you learned from today's lesson?

Day 5: Read Exodus 4:18-31 [\[Open NIV\]](#) [\[Open NKJV\]](#)

15. Explain how difficult it must have been for Moses to convey to Pharaoh the things God told him to say.
16. How did God use Moses's wife, Zipporah, to help Moses accomplish his mission?
17. How are you encouraged by Aaron's obedience?
18. What caused the Israelite elders to bow down and worship God? Should you worship God for the same reason as the elders of Israel? Explain your answer.
