Triangle Bible Study

Lesson 20: Exodus 38:1 – 39:43

Day 1: Read Exodus 38:1-8, Hosea 6:6, Matthew 9:13, Exodus 30:17-21, Hebrews 10:19-22 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

1. Describe how the Altar of Burnt Offering was to be made and make a list of the bronze utensils to be used there.

- 2. What perspective about burnt offerings do Hosea 6:6 and Matthew 9:13 give you? How would you apply these verses to your life?
- 3. Look back at Exodus 30:17-21 and describe how the priests used the bronze basin (laver) in the Tabernacle. How are we cleansed today? (See Hebrews 10:19-22.)

Day 2: Read Exodus 38:9-31 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

4. What were the dimensions of the courtyard (verses 9-13)? Determine the dimensions of the courtyard in feet by using Bible footnotes.

5. List the total amount of gold, silver, and bronze offered to build the Tabernacle (verses 24-31)? Look at Bible footnotes to discover the weight of each metal.

6. How many men 20 years and older belonged to the nation of Israel (verse 26)?

Day 3: Read Exodus 39:1-21, Proverbs 2:7, Psalm 89:18, Psalm 119:114 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 7. What two main garments of clothing for the Priests are mentioned in today's passage? Describe them both.
- 8. Explain the symbolism of a breastplate (or shield) using Proverbs 2:7, Psalm 89:18, and Psalm 119:114.

Day 4: Read Exodus 39:22-31, Genesis 41:42, Leviticus 16:4, Revelation 19:8-14 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 9. Make a list of garments, other than the ephod and breastplate, worn by the Priests.
- 10. Linen is mentioned as material for several of the Priests' garments. Explain the spiritual significance of linen using the following cross-references.

Genesis 41:42

Leviticus 16:4

Revelation 19:8-14

Day 5: Read Exodus 39:32-43, Matthew 10:30 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 11. Using today's Bible passage, give an example of leadership demonstrated by Moses.
- 12. Clearly God cares about details applied to the Tabernacle and you. (See Matthew 10:30.) What has encouraged you about God being active in the details of your life?.
- 13. Why was verse 43 beneficial to God's people then and today?
