- 8. What actions are NOT connected to one's salvation (vs. 8-9)? Explain how Titus 3:4-5 complement the truth of Ephesians 2:8-9.
- 9. Apply v. 10 to your life.

# Day 4: Read Ephesians 2:11-18 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 10. Why should Gentiles and Jews rejoice in the truth of today's scriptures?
- 11. How did Jesus destroy the barrier between Jew and Gentile (vs. 14-18)?

12. What part of today's lesson will you commit to apply to your life?

#### Day 5: Read Ephesians 2:19-22, 1 Corinthians 3:16-17 [Open NIV] [Open NKJV]

- 13. Who are no longer foreigners and aliens in Christ (v. 19)?
- 14. On whom is the foundation of the church built and who is the chief cornerstone of the church (v. 20)?
- 15. Explain how 1 Corinthians 3:16-17 helps you understand Ephesians 2:21-22.
